



# 2023 IMPACT REPORT

Sojourner Truth House is dedicated to providing support and resources for individuals and families in need. Through various programs and services, Sojourner Truth House aims to empower individuals to overcome challenges and thrive in their communities.

2023 saw the following:

- An average of **2,402** clients served each month
- **247,430** pounds of food distributed through the food pantry, which fed an average of **767** families each month
- An average of **71** home visits made per month by case managers to **90** households living in supportive housing through the Gateway and South Shore Commons programs
- **37** individuals moved into stable housing
- **6,851** volunteer hours, with an average of **40** individual volunteers per month. That is the equivalent of **\$197,612\***!
- STH offers case management and support services to **60** households in the SouthShore Commons and 52 households in the Gateway program.

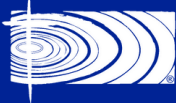

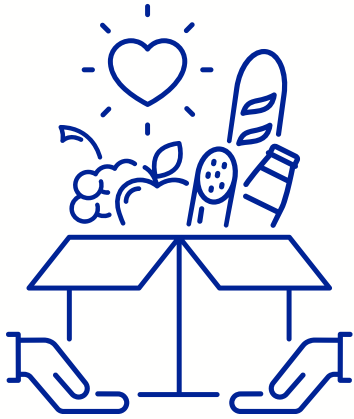

Our food pantry is Lake County’s largest and one of the only that provide personal care items as well. Three days a week, we serve an average of 80 households each day. But due to high inflation, we’re seeing an increase in hunger and food insecurity in our community.

You and other supporters ensured that STH’s food pantry:

- Served **9,128** households (an average of 767 per month), **7.6** percent more than in 2022.
- Distributed **247,430** pounds of food (an average of 28 pounds of food per household, per month)
- Prepared and served **7,804** wholesome, home-cooked meals from our kitchen
- Provided a wide range of healthy foods—milk, eggs, butter, meat, fresh fruits and vegetables
- **44,806** pounds of in-kind food donations were received, which helped stock the pantry shelves.

Our Community Garden is also a vital part of Sojourner Truth House. According to the USDA, there are **14** food deserts in Gary, meaning **33%** of residents live more than a mile from a grocery store. Every month, we provide food boxes for hundreds of families, and during growing season we depend on our garden to provide supplemental food.

The garden annually averages approximately **1,050** pounds of produce. This fresh food is served in meals from our kitchen, distributed in food boxes through the pantry, and shared with our neighbors.
