

Revelation 3:6-8, 12-13




Letter of Saint Katharina to the Councilors

December 18th, 1887

Let us commend our Congregation to God the Holy Spirit. May the Holy Spirit guide, lead, direct, animate, and inspirit the Congregation generally and each Sister, each house, each undertaking in all detail, whether it has to do with leaders, other Sisters, or with those entrusted to our care, the children and the sick. There is to be nothing in us or around us that is not living and working for God. We should also talk about the many graces we have received in religious life and that we want to cooperate with grace faithfully. May the Holy Spirit guide, animate, enlighten, and strengthen us through and for all the works and actions according to God's holy will and pleasure.

All: Holy Spirit, lead us into deeper and diverse ways of being community.





Celebrant: The Lord be with you.


All: And with your spirit.

All: We lift them up to the Lord.





Invitation to Communion


Celebrant: Behold the Lamb of God, behold him who takes away the sins of the world. Blessed are those called to the supper of the Lamb.

All: Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed.


